

Denny North Substation Peat Storage Area We'd like to find out what you think

ScottishPower Transmission Ltd (SPT), as part of the construction of the Denny North substation, is proposing to create a peat storage area on land to the south of Langlands Farm, near Denny.

Our proposal involves the creation of a peat storage area to manage peat generated by the construction of the new Denny North substation. This will also allow the restoration of the existing bog and the ecological improvement of marshy grassland adjacent to the substation site.

Considerable environmental planning has been undertaken to minimise the environmental impact of the proposals and as part of our consultation process we want to give you the opportunity to comment on the proposals prior to a planning application being submitted to Falkirk Council.
