Sue has been recognised in OUTstanding’s annual global list for five consecutive years. Sue has also been recognised as a top 50 Global EMpower Executive for creating a more inclusive business environment for ethnic minority employees, and has been listed in the top 100 HERoes Women Executives List for her efforts in prioritising gender diversity in financial services.
