Following submission of the above planning application, SPEN write to provide an addendum to the submitted EIA Report, Volume 1 – Chapter 4 – Project Description.

Paragraph 4.4.55 of Chapter 4 – Project Description of the EIA Report, detailed permanent works were to include a diesel generator and storage of up to 90,000 litres of insulating oil.

SPEN confirm the diesel generator is an existing piece of plant on site and in turn is not proposed. In addition, the storage of up to 90,000 litres of insulating oil is no longer proposed.
