SP Energy Networks is upgrading the grid in central and southern Scotland. With total electricity demand set to double by 2050, we need a grid that's ready to meet future energy needs, while boosting the nation's energy security for generations to come.

To help make this happen, we need to extend our Mossmorran substation, near Cowdenbeath, and increase the voltage of existing overhead lines in Fife. This will help strengthen the electricity transmission network and guarantee secure energy supplies for the future.

In 2024, we consulted local people on our initial proposals. We have now refined our plans and are holding a further public consultation so local people can give us their views to help us develop the project in the best way.
