



Proposed 132kV Grid Connection to Rogerhill Solar & Battery Energy Storage System Public Consultation Feedback Form

Please note the last day for submitting your feedback is Sunday 1st March 2026

SP Energy Networks (SPEN), through its transmission licence holder Scottish Power Transmission plc (SPT), proposes to construct two 132kV “Trident” overhead line circuits in South Lanarkshire. The total length of this new grid connection is approximately 7.2 km.

The connection is required to allow the proposed Rogerhill Solar and Battery Energy Storage System development to input to the electricity network. To comply with its statutory and licence obligations, SPT must provide the proposed development with a connection to the existing transmission system.

Our proposal involves a grid connection from the proposed Rogerhill Solar and Battery Energy Storage System to Coalburn North Substation.

A Routeing and Consultation Document has been prepared providing details of the initial stages of work to identify a Preferred Route for the grid connection. This has involved the review of key environmental features of the Study Area, identification of alternative routes and analysis of route options. From the outset, SPEN has focussed on reducing the environmental impact of the proposed development, whilst remaining technically and economically viable.
